Inspection With your stethoscope, identify the first and second heart sounds (S1 and S2). Begin auscultation at the apex of the heart in the fifth intercostal space to the left of the sternum. Listen with the bell of the stethoscope. Then, proceed to the tricuspid area and up the left sternal border to the second intercostal space of the pulmonic on the left and aortic on the right. Place the diaphragm directly on the patients skin, and press firmly to hear high-pitched sounds, such as S1 and S2. Use the bell to hear low-pitched sounds, which are often abnormal. But lay the bell gently on the chest; pressing it firmly will make it function like a diaphragm.
